Literacy

Read, Read, READ sharing stories is one of the most beneficial activities you can do with your child. You reading to them or them reading to you will allow them to practice sounds they know, develop fluency and hear new vocabulary.

Please continue to practice all our sounds using the set you have at home. You can also practice spelling these in words. I have uploaded all the spelling sheets in files called Spelling Homework on Teams. You can also continue to use phonics play for lots of games to practice these.

It is important that children continue to practice their formation of letters, capital letters and numbers on lines to support their writing. Remember building strength in our fingers helps us develop this, so lots of activities such as threading, dough disco and finger gyms are great to develop hand muscles.

Children also need to continue to develop their writing ability therefore providing purposeful opportunities to write are so important. You might choose to:

- Play a Game and write some instructions.
- Read a story/watch a film and describe settings, characters, or rewrite the story in a different way.
- Do some baking and write the ingredients and instructions.
- Make your own helicopter story and act it out with toys.
- Write a letter or postcard to your teacher, friends or family.
- Keep a diary of things that you do each day.
- Find pictures and get children to write a sentence/label the picture.

Art and Design
